If I am a student, what should I expect?

<u>Online Information Update</u>: This process is to verify emergency contact information for your student. If you have not completed this process it will need to be completed before Arena Check-In. In late April, all current student households received instructions by <u>email</u> to complete this process. <u>Pre-Picture Day (Optional)</u>: Thursday August 8, 2024, 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM in the New Gym. Students may have their picture taken prior to Arena Check-In to avoid waiting in line. We will start with digital ID cards, and physical ID cards will be distributed to your student's English class at a later date.

Drop-Off and Parking Information:

If you will be dropping off your student, the most convenient location is the Gym Parking lot off of Ringwood (T-Lot). Please use this same lot for pick-up. If you plan to park and join the Parent/Guardian Welcome Event, please use the main parking lot at Ringwood/Middlefield Road. We will have staff on campus to direct you to the gym area once you have parked your vehicle.
